

Jorge is Thankful!

My family and I came from Cuba when I was 6 years old. It was my goal to play baseball professionally when I was a kid. My team even won the state championship. As a teenager, I injured my knee really bad while playing and the doctor told me I could never play baseball professionally. It was a life changing experience for me because I was set on playing baseball. From that moment on, my life took a turn for the worse. I started hanging out with a bad crowd and started doing drugs. I became a functioning addict. During a drug deal, I was shot at, but the bullet miraculously missed hitting me. This was a wake up call for me and I enlisted in the Navy to get away from drugs and the gangs. After 4 years, I ended up getting kicked out for smoking marijuana and other things. I just gave up on life. I ended up homeless and living under a bridge. I came to the realization that I needed to change my life. A friend of mine suggested that I go to the Miami Rescue Mission. The basic reason I went and was willing to change my life was because I believed God had a plan for me from a very young age, but I was not willing to follow Him. A short time after entering the program, I committed my life to Jesus Christ. I started seeing what His purpose for me was. It hasn't been easy to change, but I'm so thankful for all the help and love I have received. I'm now enrolled in Miami-Dade College and studying to be an addictions

counselor. I pray that I will be able to help others overcome addiction and homelessness in the


Your Support Touches and Transforms Lives!
